

Public Notice:

Redwood County is planning to undertake the replacement of Bridge 89850, also known as Goldmine Bridge, funded in part by the Federal Highway Administration. The project is located along CSAH 17/21 at the border of Redwood and Renville County over the Minnesota River.

Under the preferred alternative, the proposed project would involve the removal of the historic Goldmine Bridge and realign CSAH 21 in Renville County to cross the Minnesota River east of its current location on a new bridge.

Properties listed in or eligible for the National Register of Historic Places (NRHP) located within the Area of Potential Effects (APE) include Goldmine Bridge (Bridge No. 89850). The proposed action impacts properties eligible for the NRHP. In accordance with the National Historic Preservation Act, the views of the public are being sought regarding the effect of the proposed project on the historic elements as per 36 CFR 800.2(d), 800.3(e) and 800.6(a)(4). Pursuant to 36 CFR 800.4(d)(2), the documentation specified in 36 CFR 800.11(e) is available for inspection in Redwood County Highway Office. This documentation serves as the basis for the Section 106 Adverse Effect finding. The views of the public on identification of historic properties and proposed replacement of Goldmine Bridge are being sought.
