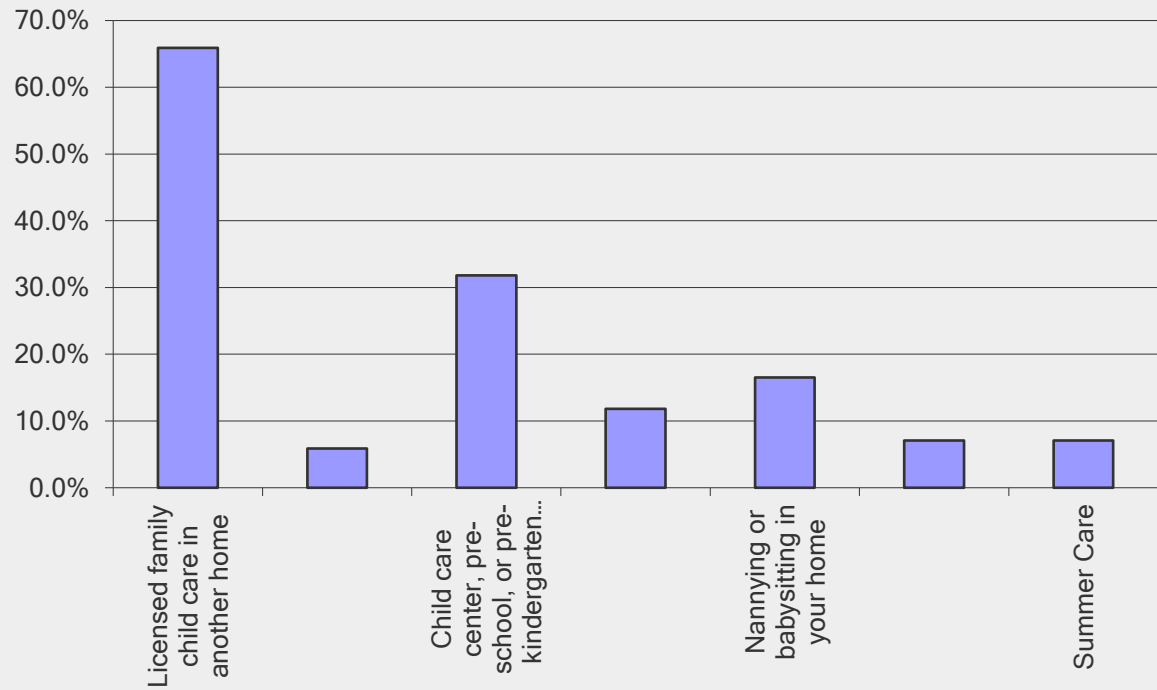

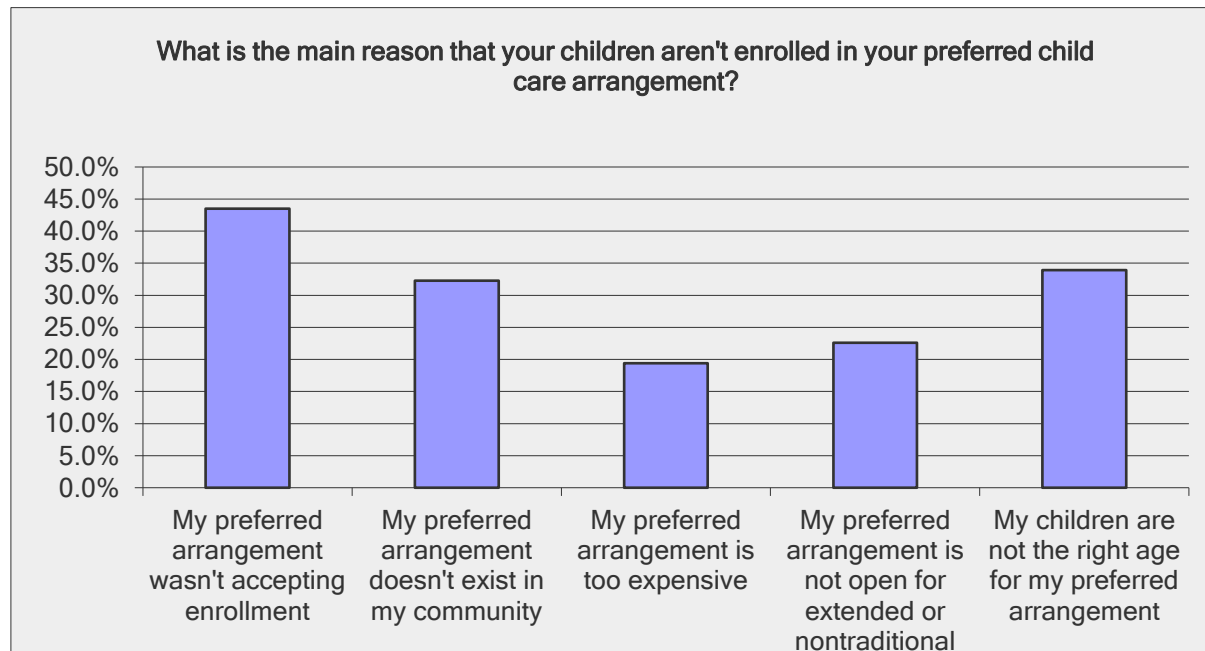

How difficult would you say it is to enroll in your preferred child care option?

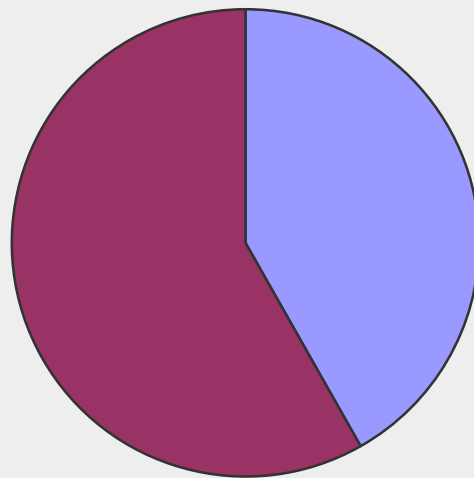

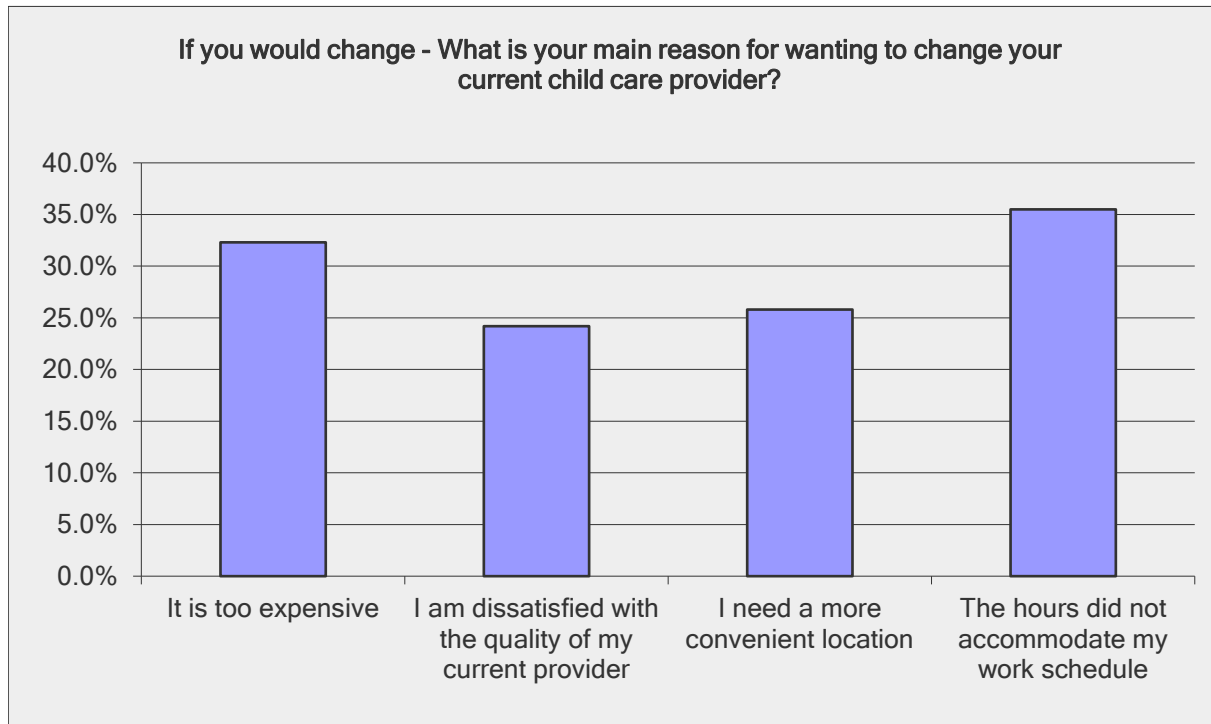

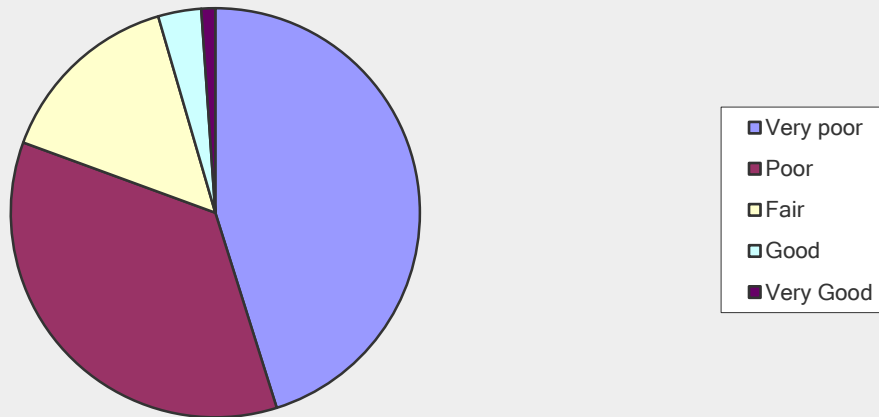

How would you rate AVAILABILITY of child care options in Redwood County and surrounding area? Note: availability means the access to child care in the area.



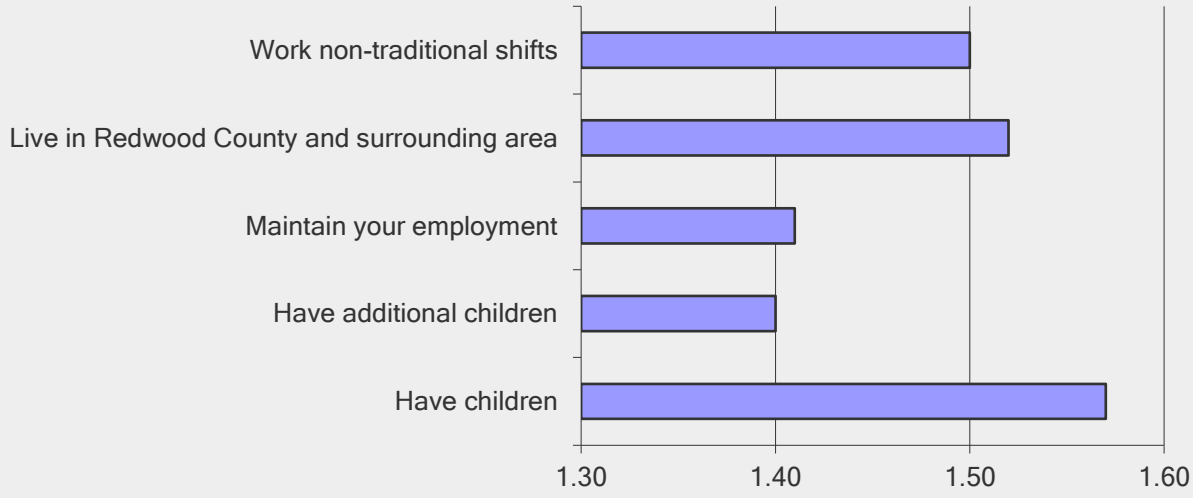

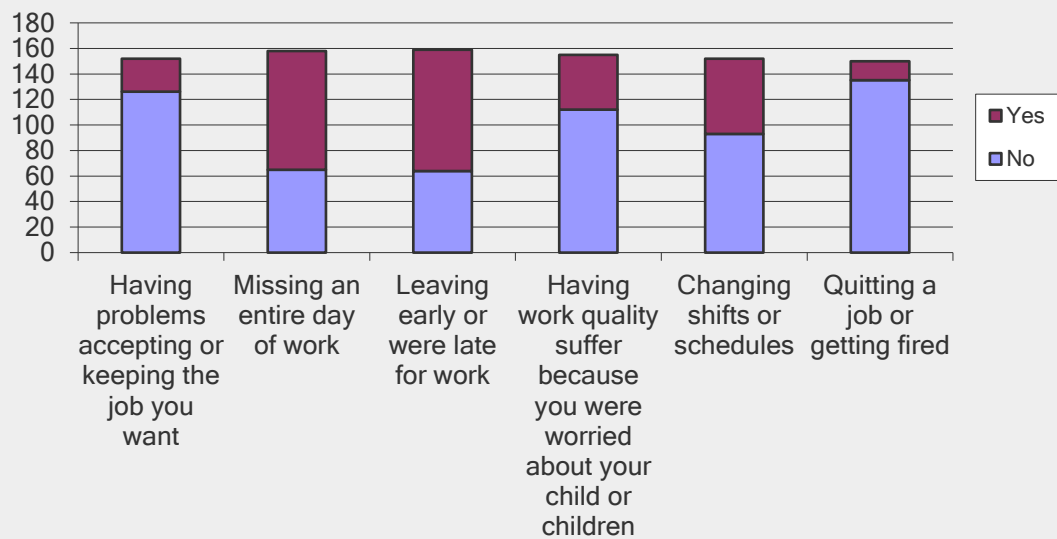

At the time I accepted the job, I began searching for daycare for my 4 month old. I obtained a list of the daycare providers from the DHS website and started at the top of the list. Out of the 25 on the list, there were only 5 with openings. After visiting the 5, we felt comfortable with only 1. This was not our preferred form of childcare as we had been using the YMCA while in Willmar. We preferred a facility as we were not familiar with any of the available daycare providers and had a hard time bringing my new baby to a person I knew nothing about. By the grace of God, we landed an outstanding daycare provider and could not be happier, however she did not have an opening for our baby until early August. I had to delay transitioning to the new job for about a month until I found a temporary option for two months (through Grandma). Two years later, we were expecting our second child. We notified our daycare provider the moment we found out we were expecting to start working the details of availability after my maternity leave. Based on the number of kids she had, she would not have a full time opening until two months after I returned to work. We were unable to find temporary daycare for our baby locally (still using our daycare provider for our other child) and so worked it out to have a friend in Bird Island watch our new baby until the opening in RW became available in September 2013. This was a difficult time for us as a family. I was traveling to Bird Island in the mornings to leave my baby with one person and then travel to RW to bring my toddler to our daycare provider. I spent time commuting, stressing about having my kids in two places and even a loss of productivity as I had to leave my job and go pick up my baby when our friends kids became sick. I can say for a fact the RW community is truly struggling in the same way we had 5 years ago. I've had a number of people describe their experience seeking daycare for their new baby and have been told they have had to delay returning to work or utilizing Grandparents until FT daycare is available.
